



DRILL RIG OPERATOR

Summary: Operates a drill rig and manages on-site geotechnical and environmental drilling projects, including hollow stem auger drilling, mud-rotary drilling, rock coring, and monitoring well installation. Travel (including overnight) is typical, with transportation, lodging and per diem expenses provided by the company.

Experience with the following is preferred:

- Operating Central Mine Equipment (CME) ATV and truck-mounted drills
- Completing projects on time and according to project specifications
- Communicating constructively and timely with supervisors and project team members to ensure that project requirements are met and processes flow smoothly
- Escalating issues that cannot be solved at the front line to the appropriate person timely
- Performing routine maintenance, minor mechanical repairs, and associated record keeping
- Representing company interests professionally with partner and clients

Requirements:

- Must have a valid commercial driver's license with a clean driving record
- Must submit to and be successful in annual DOT physical/medical assessments
- Ability to push, pull and/or lift up to 70 lbs. regularly
- Ability to push, pull and/or lift 80 pounds occasionally
- Ability to bend, squat and reach often
- Ability to stand for long periods throughout the day
- Ability to work in all weather conditions
- Adequate eyesight or adequately corrected eyesight to ensure safety and accuracy
- Adequate hearing to ensure safety and communication
- Adherence to all personal protective equipment requirements and safety rules
