- Collect and analyze social, economic and environmental data to be used in analyzing project impact and recommendations.
- Prepare reports and regulatory permits and approvals in compliance with environmental laws.

- Bachelor's degree in Environmental Science, Geology, or related Engineering degree
- Minimum of 3 years of experience with NEPA projects that includes all aspects of NEPA projects, including data analysis, report writing and project implementation
- Federal NEPA experience a plus
- Established knowledge of State and Federal environmental regulations and guidelines
- Proficiency in technical writing of environmental documents
- Excellent communication skills and able to work on a collaborative team, both internally and externally, and in both leadership and support roles
